Contact Management

Persons and organizations are managed separately in PluriWorks. They can be linked together in various ways. This is different than the usual way to maintain contacts in Outlook, since you do not have to deduplicate parts of the information anymore. In case you want to associate many employees to a company, you won't have to input the company information for each employee.

Distribution lists are updated automatically without having to reprocess their content individually.

The contact management system has all the advantages of Outlook, without its limits. Big mailings won't be a problem anymore, and each recipient will get the mail as if it had been delivered personally.

All contacts are available from within Outlook. You can keep using your usual mail client and still benefit from the contact management system of PluriWorks.

This module also automates mailings directly from Microsoft Word without preliminary knowledge of merger tools, and by skipping most of the usual steps.

Searches can be done on any number of combined fields (custom or not) and links among companies and persons.

Filing System

This is the place where you can store all of your files like you would within a Windows folder, but again, with more flexibility and without the filename limitation. With the PluriWorks, you can add meta information to files to further describe their content. You can for instance associate a small abstract to a file, and use that abstract on your web site.

A PluriWorks folder can not only contain files, but also contacts. This makes it possible to create a folder acting as a working group that will contain both the contacts and the files associated to that working group. That same folder could also carry a property that will make it a publishing folder, meaning that its content will then securely be synchronized with your website.

You can create as many folders as you want, nested or not, and synchronize them with multiple websites.

A file content may be useful to various working groups. PluriWorks handles this by referencing its content within the different groups. Contrary to a Windows shortcut, the referenced links will never be broken. The content will only be removed once the last link is removed. The same way, if one updates the content in one place, it gets updated everywhere.

The user can search in a Google-like way through all the content, the document names, the custom fields, etc. The results appear sorted by folder in a few seconds.

Document versioning is a standard feature of our PluriWorks. You do not have to keep a set of numbered files for all the intermediate versions of a document. PluriWorks will maintain them for you.

Archiving obsolete documents is challenging and time consuming. PluriWorks solves this by introducing the concept of TimeToLive for files. Once the number of days is reached, the document is marked as old. If it was stored in a publishing folder, it would also disappear automatically from the associated web sites.

Security

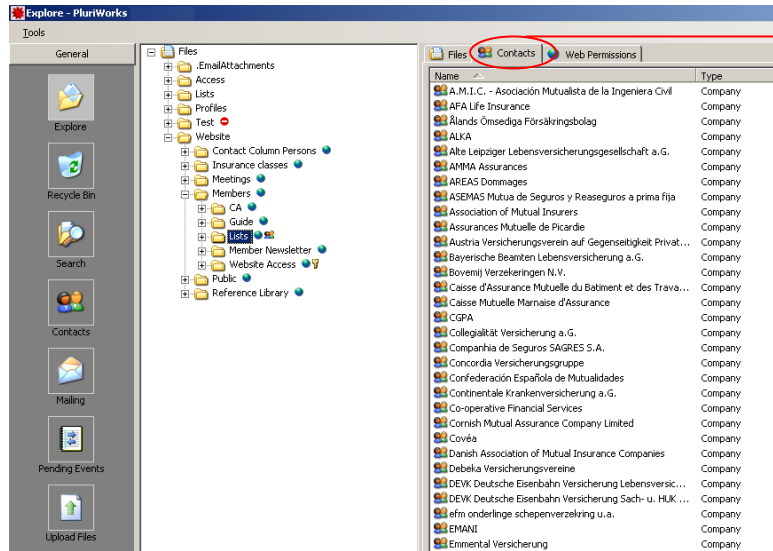
PluriWorks was produced with the SbD (Secure-By-Default) concept in mind.

User interaction will always be necessary to reach a less secure level. For instance, no files will be published on the Internet by default. To publish them, a user has to mark the containing folder as a publishing folder. This uploads the file to the website, but it will still be unavailable as long as the user has not given permissions to a particular security group.

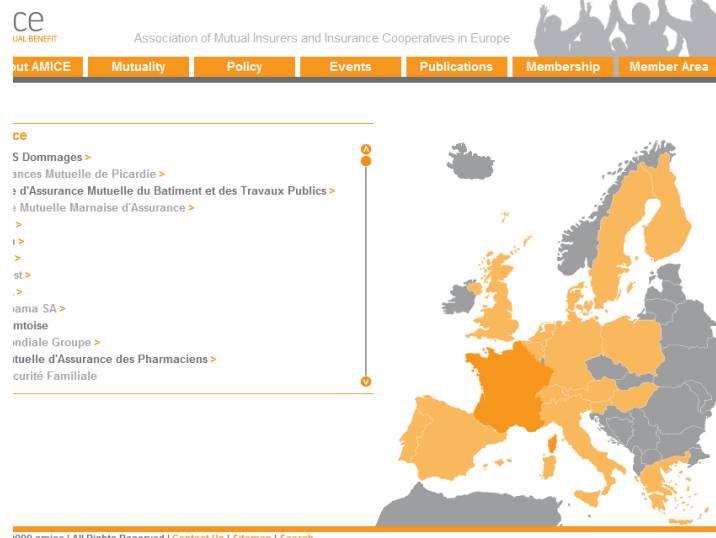
Permissions can be set in various places: folders, files, contacts, etc.

Communication and web site synchronization

PluriWorks can securely synchronize data to multiple websites. Users do not need any development knowledge to maintain their websites, nor do they have to upload documents to the sites. Everything is done automatically overnight. It is always possible to manually force a synchronization in case of an urgent publication.
